Correctional facilities across the U.S. house approximately 1.5 million inmates.¹ In 2014, 18 states plus the federal correctional system were operating above their maximum capacity.¹ As a result, inmates outnumber staff 5 to 1 (up from 4 to 1 back in 2000).² It's no surprise that with fewer eyes on the prison population, assaults and contraband confiscations are on the rise.^{2,3,4,5} And, tragically, inmate deaths are at their highest number since 2007. Since 2009, suicides committed in jails have shot up 12%, leaving these facilities open to lawsuits and public scrutiny.

Although no facility can be 100% secure, there are many easy steps facilities can take to reduce environmental risk factors. No detail will be overlooked by inmates, so no detail can be overlooked by facilities. SB-190 is the most recognized pick-resistant sealant, so facilities can be sure that their environments and inmates are exceptionally secure.
